- All high school students in Manitoba are eligible
- Individually or as a team, students create a unique product or service or business idea:
 - DigiParent (app to limit internet use by kids)
 - Urbin Solutions (self-sorting waste bin)
 - Gourmet Marshmallows
 - Water vending machine with flavour shots
- Judges are local business professionals
- Students can apply to compete in one, two, three or all of the events!

Trade Show

- The team's product or service is presented as a tabletop display
- Judges evaluate students on their table display and concept pitch
- Students are allowed to sell their product to judges and spectators so don't forget to bring extra!







Idea Pitch



- 1 2 students from each team pitch their venture to judges
- Teams will have 2 minutes to explain their venture followed by Q & A from the judges
- No visual aids or props are allowed





Logo & Branding Competition

- A logo is the company's single most visible representation within their target market
- A strong logo can establish your brand identity

Teams will have 1 minute to explain their logo

followed by a Q & A from the judges







Business Plan Competition

- 10 minute presentation
- 10 minute question & answer
- 5 minute feedback session
- 5 divisions compete in Opening Round
- Winner of each division qualifies to compete in the Championship Round







Executive Summary

Topics to included in your 1 – 2 page executive summary:

- Magnitude of the Problem
- Brief outline of the Solution
- What market validation has been completed?
- What are the financial projections
- How scalable is the idea?



*All scholarships can be used towards any post secondary institution in Manitoba.

What does a Business Plan contain?



Business Plan

Expand on the topics of your executive summary along with:

- Business Overview
 - Type of business, description of product or service
 - Overview of the current market
- Market Research
 - Is their a need for your product or service?
 - Competitive analysis (how your idea is better than others!)
- Marketing Plan
 - Product, price, place, promotion
- Financial Plan
 - Start- up budget
 - Required funds
 - Expected sales

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Awards

- Business Plan Competition:
 - First Place: \$2,000 scholarship per student
 - Second Place: \$1,000 scholarship per student
 - Third Place: \$500 scholarship per student
 - Fourth Place: \$250 scholarship per student
- Trade Show Winner: \$500 per group

- Idea Pitch Winner: \$500 per group
